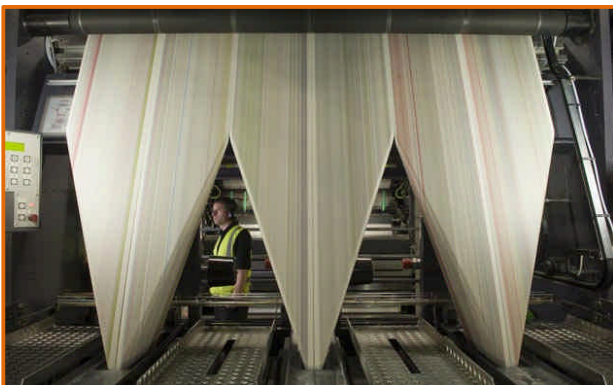
This fantastic new facility, part of a £650 Million investment around the UK, boasts some of the latest print technology on a single site the size
