Saica has given the go ahead for construction to begin on its £290m paper mill, Trafford, Manchester. Construction of the mill is due to begin in early 2010, with operations due to commence in February 2012.

Once fully operational, the mill will produce 400,000 TPY of CCM grades from 100% recycled fibre. Once up and running, the 7.5m wide machine will operate at speeds up to 1,500 mpm, producing high performance containerboard at weights of 75-125gsm. The mill will be fully integrated and use CHP, as well as advanced effluent treatment.

The group currently has 6 paper machines in France and Spain, 56 corrugating plants, and 40 paper collection/recycling plants. In the UK, the group has 11 integrated corrugating sites and 7 sheet plants.
